

## **Imposition of a requirement to self-isolate by the Medical Officer of Health under the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 4) Regulations, 2020 ("the Regulations")**

In light of the global COVID-19 pandemic, under the Regulations all persons arriving in the Bailiwick from anywhere in the world (including, for the avoidance of doubt, Jersey and the United Kingdom) must self-isolate for 14 days on arrival. This is a legal requirement, and failure to comply is a criminal offence which carries a maximum fine of £10,000. For the purposes of the Regulations, the whole world, apart from the Bailiwick, is an infected area.

**Your self-isolation starts today. Provided that you feel well and have no symptoms, you may leave isolation after completing your 14<sup>th</sup> full day. EXAMPLE: if you landed in Guernsey on 1<sup>st</sup> June your self-isolation would be complete at midnight on 14<sup>th</sup> June and you could leave self-isolation on or after 00:01 on 15<sup>th</sup> June.**

**If at any time during your isolation you develop any symptoms such as fever, muscle ache, headache, loss of smell/taste, cough, sore throat or shortness of breath, telephone the Coronavirus helpline 01481 756938 or 01491 756969 for advice and to arrange a test.**

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### **Passenger information required for all travellers to the Bailiwick who are now required to self-isolate for 14 days.**

1. Any person arriving in the Bailiwick from anywhere in the world (including, for the avoidance of doubt, Jersey and the United Kingdom) is required to provide the information specified below, and satisfactory proof of his or her identity to any customs officer, police officer or other authorised person who requests the information. This information is required in order to enable the Medical Officer of Health to contact that person without delay during the period of self-isolation.

2. Where a person fails to comply with the requirement in paragraph 1, including where he or she is reasonably suspected to have provided false or misleading information or documents in connection with that requirement, that person may be detained until he or she complies with the requirement and any other screening requirements that the Medical Officer of Health may impose.

The States of Guernsey will process the personal data collected via this form in accordance with the Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2017.
