

Requirement to self-isolate under the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (General Provision) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 8) Regulations, 2020

Every person arriving in the Bailiwick of Guernsey from anywhere in the world must provide travel information prior to or on arrival.

If you have already provided information electronically using the Travel Tracker in relation to your travel in the 7 days immediately prior to your arrival in the Bailiwick, you **must update this information if it is no longer accurate**.

If you have not already provided that information, **you must do so on your arrival in the Bailiwick**.

The Travel Tracker will inform you of your period of mandatory self-isolation and the conditions and restrictions which will apply to you when you are no longer required to self-isolate. **You must tick the relevant box in paragraph 1-5 which applies to you and sign the form to confirm you have understood your obligations.**

Along with satisfactory proof of your identity, you may also be required to provide additional travel documents or further information on your travel to any customs officer, police officer or other relevant officer who requests it.

Where a person fails to do so when required, or provides false or misleading information or documents, they may be prosecuted and, if convicted, be sentenced to pay a fine of up to £2,000.

1. Where the Travel Tracker has informed you that you are not subject to self-isolation requirements (you have NOT been in any Category 2, 3 or 4 countries in the 7 days prior to your arrival in the Bailiwick):

The Travel Tracker has informed me that I am not subject to any self-isolation or testing requirements.

2. Where the Travel Tracker has informed you that you are eligible for the Category 2 option (you have NOT been in any Category 3 or 4 countries in the 7 days prior to your arrival in the Bailiwick):

The Travel Tracker has informed me that I am eligible for the Category 2 option AND I wish to opt for this.

I confirm I have read and understood my obligation to:

- undertake a self-administered swab on arrival;
- **self-isolate** until I receive a negative test result following my swab on the day of arrival;
- comply with the conditions and restrictions required under **enhanced passive follow-up** even if I receive a negative test result from that swab;
- present myself for a further swab on or around day 7 after my arrival in the Bailiwick; and
- comply with the conditions and restrictions required under **passive follow-up** until the relevant 14 day period has ended (see the date stamp on your receipt).

3. Where the Travel Tracker has informed you that you are eligible for the Category 3 option (you have NOT been in any Category 4 countries in the 7 days prior to your arrival in the Bailiwick):

The Travel Tracker has informed me that I am eligible for the Category 3 option AND I wish to opt for this.

I confirm I have read and understood my obligation to:

- undertake a self-administered swab on arrival;
- **self-isolate** until the relevant 14 day period has ended UNLESS I receive a negative test result following my swab on or around day 7;
- present myself for a further swab on or around day 7 after my arrival in the Bailiwick; and
- even if I receive a negative test result following the swab on or around day 7 comply with the conditions and restrictions required under **enhanced passive follow-up** until the relevant 14 day period has ended (see the date stamp on your receipt).

4. Where the Travel Tracker has informed you that you are subject to Category 4 self-isolation requirements OR you do NOT wish to opt for either of the previous options where:

The Travel Tracker has informed me that I am NOT eligible for either of the above options.

The Travel Tracker has informed me that I am eligible for one of the above options BUT I do not wish to opt for either of them.

I confirm I have read and understood my obligation to **self-isolate** until the relevant 14 day period has ended (see the date stamp on your receipt). I also understand that I am not required to undertake a self-administered swab on arrival, but am encouraged to do so to assist Public Health in contact tracing and preventing the spread of COVID-19. I further understand that a negative test result from the swab on arrival will not reduce my period of mandatory self-isolation.

5. Where you have an exemption (including a variation):

I have an exemption (including a variation) which I will present on arrival in the Bailiwick.

I confirm I have an exemption (including a variation) which permits specified activities on the basis that I **comply with the conditions set out** in that exemption, but that I must otherwise **self-isolate until the end of the relevant 14 day period or as otherwise set out in the exemption.**

For all:

I confirm that I have provided true, accurate and up-to-date information in relation to my travel in the 7 days immediately prior to my arrival in the Bailiwick of Guernsey (including that provided electronically using the Travel Tracker), and that I understand if I fail to comply with the relevant obligation, conditions and/or restrictions mentioned above, I may be prosecuted and, if convicted, be sentenced to pay a fine.
