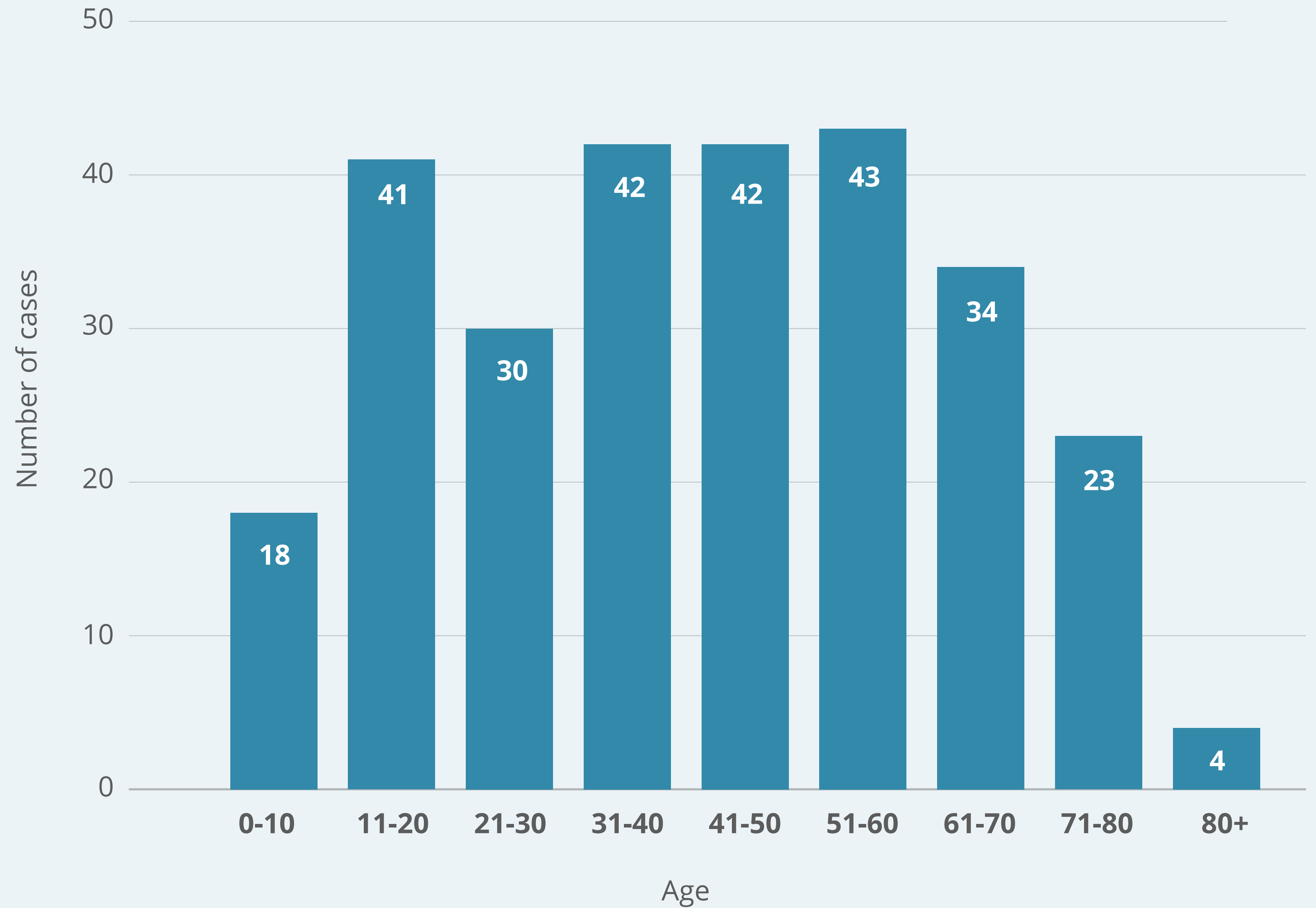

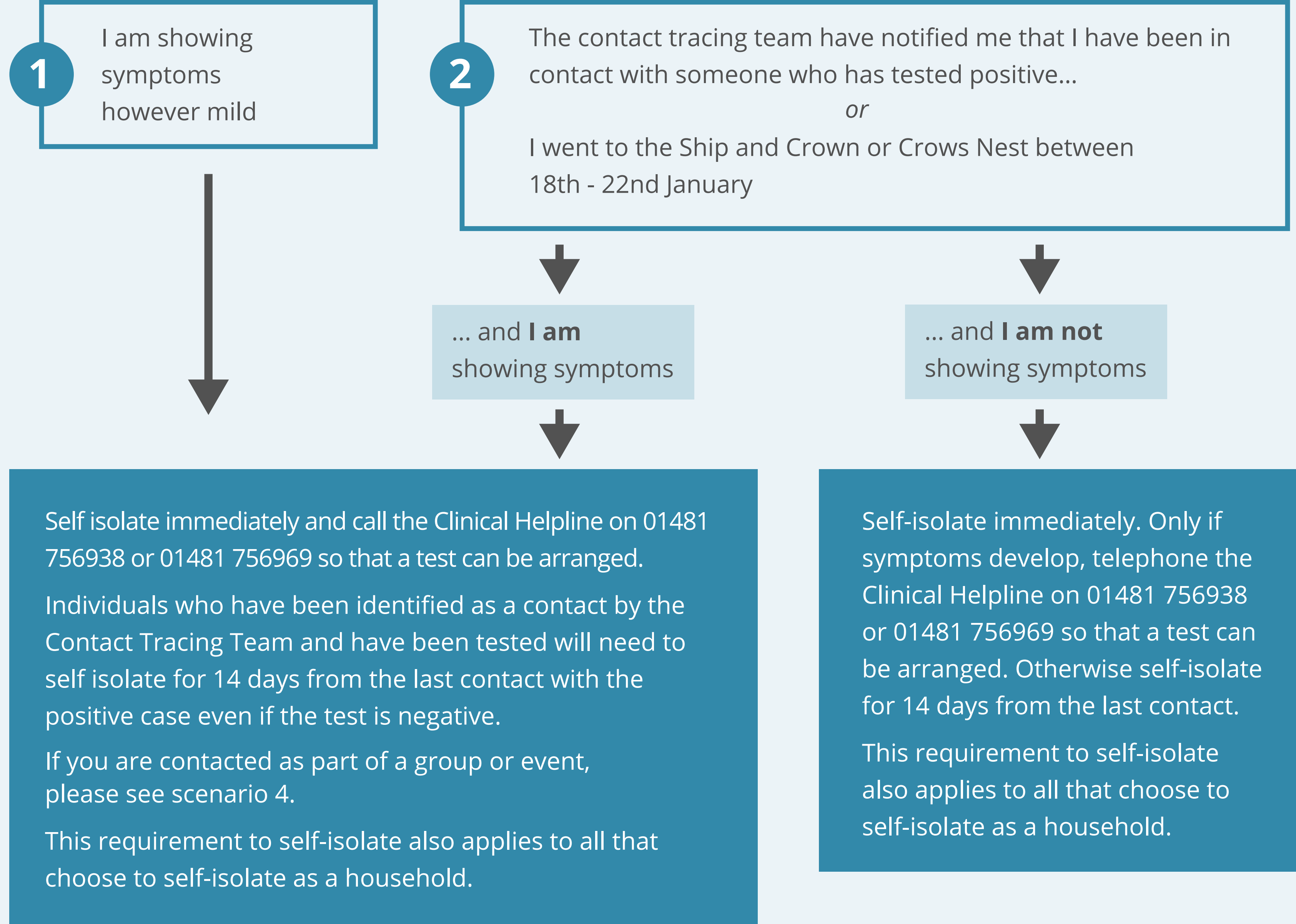

I, or a member of my household, attended the Festival of Dance, held at Beau Sejour between 19th and 22nd January.



Your whole household must immediately self-isolate. Only if symptoms develop, call the Clinical Helpline on 01481 756938 or 01481 756969 so that a test can be arranged. Otherwise, the household self-isolation period will end 14 days after the last day of attendance at the festival.

I have been contacted by the organiser of an event I attended, who has received an email from Public Health informing them that a person at the event they organised has tested positive and would have been potentially infectious while attending this event. I attended this event. For school groups the organiser might be the head teacher of your child's school referring to a day when your child was at school.

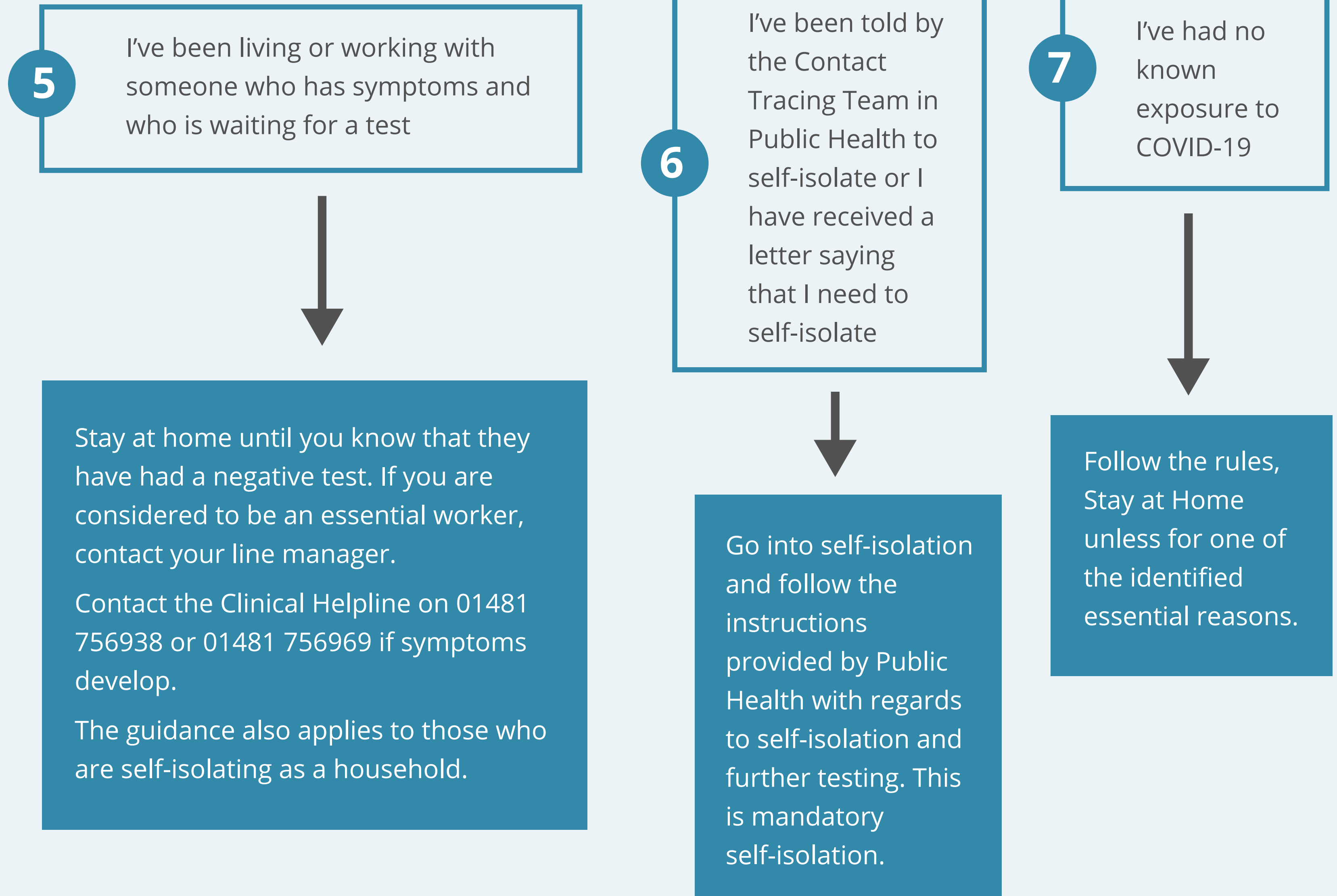


Self-isolate immediately. Only if symptoms develop, call the Clinical Helpline on 01481 756938 or 01481 756969 so that a test can be arranged.
