

Here is some useful information about your COVID vaccination



Coronavirus is a type of illness that can make people very sick



We now have a vaccine that can stop people getting so sick



Every adult in the Bailiwick will be offered a vaccine



The more people that have the vaccine, the safer we can all be



Everyone will need two vaccinations a few weeks apart. These are sometimes called 'doses'



Getting the vaccine is easy



You do not need to pay for the vaccine



The people who can get very sick from coronavirus have already had their vaccine



Your doctor has said you are a medium risk person. So now it's your turn



Having the vaccine is your choice. This is called 'consent'



To book your appointment, call 01481 707607. If you need help, someone can call for you



You can also book in your primary carer to have their vaccination at the same time as you



The telephone lines are open during the day. You can call 8am-8pm Monday to Friday, or 8am-12pm on Saturday or Sunday. We will ask your name and date of birth
