Group 7

All those ages 60 years of age and over

Invitation letters will be posted out in batches starting on Monday 15 March 2021.
All invitation letters should have been posted by 20 March 2021. Everyone in this priority group should have received their first dose by w/ending Sunday 28 March 2021.



Group 8

All those ages 55 years of age and over

Vaccine delivered
in the Community
Vaccination Centre

Invitation letters will be posted out in batches starting on Monday 22 March 2021.
Everyone in this priority group should have received their first dose by Saturday 10 April 2021.



Group 9

All those ages 50 years of age and over

Vaccine delivered
in the Community
Vaccination Centre

Invitation letters will be posted out in batches starting on Tuesday 6 April 2021.
This week also sees those in earlier priority groups begin to receive their second dose of vaccine. Everyone in this priority group should have received their first dose by Saturday 8 May 2021.

Priority groups 6 to 9 are identified by a PHE algorithm in the UK which searches the database and looks for certain coding or 'flags' that identify patients at moderate risk. This might mean that others might be called forward during this time.



As soon as the invitations have been sent out to priority group 9 a period of 2 weeks has been set aside to hold 'mop-up' clinics for any member of any priority group who has changed their mind, changed appointment, been missed off a register etc. while simultaneously administering 2nd doses to earlier cohorts. As soon as this is in place the programme will move to phase 2 on or around Monday 24 May 2021, while still administering second doses for individuals into June 2021.



Phase 2 - vaccines for those aged 18 years and over

We are liaising with our healthcare partners to gather data on those who are in this cohort.



If you are aged 18 years and over and do not meet the requirements of groups 1 to 9 AND ARE NOT registered with a primary care practice (doctors surgery) please do so. If you are not registered we will not know about you when we come to vaccinate this group.



Phase 3 - vaccines for children and young people

We are currently planning how to vaccinate this cohort. We do not yet know how and when this cohort will receive the vaccine. This depends on the outcome of vaccine trials currently underway and approval by the various regulators. However, early stage planning is taking place to ensure we are ready as soon as the vaccine is approved for children and young people.

If you or your children ARE NOT registered with a primary care practice (doctor's surgery) please do so. If you are not registered we will not know about you when we come to vaccinate this group.
