### Vaccination Drop-In Clinics

---

In order to maximise the number of doses of vaccine that can be dispensed in any particular clinic, and to accommodate as many islanders as possible who wish to receive a COVID-19 vaccination, a series of drop-in sessions will commence this week.

The drop-in sessions will be held at the end of a morning or evening clinic and will be advertised, at short notice, on the States of Guernsey social media feeds (Facebook, Twitter or Instagram).

There will be separate sessions for the Pfizer BioNTech or Moderna vaccine (for those aged 39 or younger) and for the AstraZeneca vaccine (for those aged 40 or over). Please ensure that you check that the drop-in session being advertised is the correct one for you.

These sessions will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis, but priority will be given to those requiring to be vaccinated with a first dose.

If a person wishes to attend a drop-in session at the CVC (Community Vaccination Centre at Beau Sejour) they will need to bring the following documentation:

- A valid form of photographic identification to confirm your address and date of birth (passport, driving licence, Citizen card etc)
- Confirmation of your GY number (this can be found on Revenue Services paperwork, your payslip, Social Security correspondence etc)

There is no need to be registered with a GP.
