

Before you arrive

If you are travelling from the Common Travel Area (CTA) or arranging travel for visiting family or friends, there are some things you can do.



Please make sure you completed your Travel Tracker. This will be required before you are allowed into the Bailiwick without the need for isolation.

If you haven't filled in your Travel Tracker wifi is available in Departures and the team will be on hand to provide assistance if required. You will need an email address and proof of your vaccination status.



Please ensure you have a recognised proof of an MHRA or EMA approved vaccine, administered in the CTA, with the appropriate certification. It is strongly advised that you also bring the paper certificate. Blue appointment cards are not valid proof of vaccination. Wear a face covering while you are in transit.
