

Visiting Guernsey

The Bailiwick of Guernsey is open to visitors from the Common Travel Area (CTA) includes the UK, the Bailiwick of Jersey, the Isle of Man and the Republic of Ireland.

If travelling into the Bailiwick from anywhere outside the CTA, the current country category isolation and testing requirements apply. If you have been outside the CTA in the 14 days before you arrive in the Bailiwick then the country category applies regardless of your vaccination status.

Visitors who are fully vaccinated* plus 14 days will come in via the blue channel with no need to test or isolate on arrival.




Visitors who are not fully vaccinated* will test on arrival and isolate depending on the prevalence rate of where they have travelled from.



Children aged 11 and under will assume the vaccination status of their parents. Those aged between 12 and 17 will need a test on arrival and to self-isolate until receipt of a negative result then passive follow up until receipt of a negative day 7 test.



No need to have a PCR test before leaving or returning to the UK.



No need to self-isolate when you return to the CTA.

*An MHRA or EMA approved vaccine, administered in the CTA, with the appropriate certification.

Before you arrive

If you are travelling from the Common Travel Area (CTA) or arranging travel for visiting family or friends, there are some things you can do.



Please make sure that you have filled in your Travel Tracker (covid19.gov.gg/guidance/travel/traveltracker) prior to arriving in to the Bailiwick. You can do this from 48 hours prior to travelling.



Please ensure you have a recognised proof of an MHRA or EMA approved vaccine, administered in the CTA , with the appropriate certification. It is strongly advised that you also bring the paper certificate. Blue appointment cards are not valid proof of vaccination. Find out what is accepted at covid19.gov.gg/guidance/vaccine/passports



Wear a face covering while you are in transit.



Please arrange your onward travel from the Airport or Port prior to travel.



Double check you have not been outside of the Common Travel Area (CTA) in the 14 days prior to arriving into the Bailiwick.

Travel requirements

If you are travelling to the Bailiwick of Guernsey from the Common Travel Area (CTA) you must fill out your Travel Tracker from 48 hours prior to travelling. You must also bring a recognised proof of an MHRA or EMA approved vaccine, administered in the CTA, with the appropriate certification.
