

Travel requirements

If you are travelling to the Bailiwick of Guernsey from the Common Travel Area (CTA) you must fill out your Travel Tracker from 48 hours prior to travelling and bring a recognised proof of an MHRA or EMA approved vaccine, administered in the CTA, with the appropriate certification. It is strongly advised that you also bring the paper certificate. We also strongly recommend that visitors take a PCR or lateral flow test before travelling to the Bailiwick. If you have been in Jersey in the previous 14 days

you will need a negative PCR test, within 48 hours of travel. This includes fully vaccinated adults and all children aged 5 or older who accompany fully vaccinated adults.

No testing or isolation requirements for children aged 11 or under. From 3rd August adults will be given lateral flow tests to self-test on arrival and during their stay - no isolation requirements.



Children aged 12-17 test on arrival, isolate until receipt of a negative test then passive follow up until receipt of negative day 7 test. From 3rd August adults will be given lateral flow tests to self-test on arrival and during their stay - no isolation requirements.
