Islanders aged 30+ can receive booster tomorrow at CVC and three GP practices

Walk-in clinics will be held tomorrow (Saturday) at the Community Vaccination Centre and three GP practices for anyone aged 30+ who wants to receive their Covid-19 booster.

This will be the first-time islanders have had the opportunity to attend a GP practice for the vaccine and is part of a new joint initiative between Primary Care and the States of Guernsey to support efforts to accelerate the booster programme.

If attending one of the GP practice clinics, islanders must attend at the practice where they are registered as each only has the data for their own patients to be able to vaccinate them.

Each walk-in clinic is at a slightly different time so full details are as follows:

- Queens Road Surgery between 8.30am-1pm
- St Sampson Surgery between 9am-2pm
- St Martin's Surgery between 8am-2pm
- Community Vaccination Centre between 9.30am-8pm

Booster doses are available for anyone aged 30+ whose second dose of the vaccine was on or before 18th September 2021.

While the walk-in clinics are focused on the wider booster programme, first and second doses are also available for those who would like to have them.

Anyone attending one of the walk-in clinics is asked to take a lateral flow test beforehand and wear a face covering.
