

# COVID-19 Guidance on Unaccompanied Animal Imports/Imports using an Authorised Transporter

**DO NOT travel if you have symptoms of COVID-19.**

## Welfare in transport

- Travel time must be kept to a minimum to protect the welfare of animals being transported – if there is poor weather, it is advised that travel is postponed.
- Carriers/transporters should ensure that the animal is provided with water and comfortable and appropriate accommodation such as crates/pet carriers, including bedding, during transport.
- Transporters should hold transport authorisations from their competent authority.

## Animal handover

- It is advised that all individuals involved in animal handover should wear appropriate PPE (face covering, gloves) and have hand washing facilities/hand sanitiser available to them for use after the handover.
- All surfaces and objects (touch points) will be cleaned and disinfected thoroughly using appropriate products and equipment.
- Where appropriate, documentation should be sent electronically. Documentation which must accompany animals during transportation should be placed inside a plastic wallet that can be disinfected.
- Importers should be ready to collect animals as soon as they land.
